- Something they like, have child help pick out snack.
- Birthday treats

AM Classes

- 9am drop off at rear door of parking lot closest to playground.

PM Classes

- 12:45pm drop off at front of building by St. Mary statue.
- 3:05pm pick-up at rear door of parking lot closest to playground.

Preschool day care

- Hours 6:30am-6pm Monday-Friday
- Only students enrolled in SMS preschool
- Annual registration fee \$30.00
- Hourly rate: \$4.75 per hour
- Must provide packed lunch and snacks in separate bags.
- Milk can be purchased for lunch (\$5 for 20

Communicable Disease

- If your child becomes mildly ill at school you will be called to notify to come pick up.
- Child will be isolated from group with a preschool staff member until you or someone on your release form comes to pick up.
- If your child has a fever, they will need to be fever free without fever meds for 48 hours to return to school
