Dear St. Mary Catholic School Families,

The Advent Season will begin Sunday, December 1, 2019. This is a perfect time to concentrate and visit your faith, putting emphasis on hope & joy for the season. The Advent wreath is very symbolic of this happiness.

The Advent wreath signifies God's infinite love. It consists of an evergreen circle, symbolizing the Eternity of God. The four candles depict the four weeks of Advent. There are three violet candles and one pink. The first Sunday of Advent, represented by a purple candle, symbolizes hope; the second Sunday of Advent, represented by a purple candle, symbolizes faith, and the third Sunday of Advent, represented by a pink candle symbolizes joy. This third Sunday, (*pay attention here...Father enjoys asking the congregation if they know this term*) is known as "Gaudete" Sunday, (Rejoice). The fourth Sunday, and third purple candle, represents peace. So in preparation for Advent, organize your Advent calendar for the season, make your gift idea/ lists, have a budget, plan your charitable giving, decide what is IMPORTANT this year, and above all enjoy the spirit of Christmas.

All students will attend Mass on Monday, December 2 and Adoration on Friday, December 6.; and Grades 3-8 will participate in Confession on Friday, December 13. Please don't miss the band concert Wednesday, December 18 at 7pm in the school gym; and the 3, 4, & 5th grade vocal concert Thursday, December 19 at St. Mary Catholic Church. Both events are sure to warm and envelop your heart for the season.

There are two events planned for Saturday, December 7. The first is father/ son laser tag, from 9-11am, located at Arena 51 in Middleburg Heights. The second is the annual Berea Jack Frost parade. The parade lineup has changed. The lineup is NOT at Coe Lake. Line up is on Seminary Street in Berea. You must access Seminary Street from Church Street. The PTO requests families arrive by 5:00pm, parade begins at 5:30pm.

Eighth Grade Students and Parents

High School Selection Week will be held in January. The eighth grade students have been given a variety of opportunities to assist them in making an informed choice for high school. Mr. Jones has worked with each child to secure high school visitation days. Students received the ACAD (Association of Catholic Admission Directors) High School magazine listing all Open Houses and admission testing dates.

Your child is encouraged to spend some time over the holiday break making a final decision on where to apply and writing an application essay. Remember the application essay may be the first and only chance your child has to impress the administrators of the high school they are hoping to attend.

Parents of eighth grade students should be aware that 2^{nd} Quarter grades will be sent with the application. The selected high school will then expect parents to send a copy of your child's final June report card.
