NEW POLICY

I also have an important "electronic" policy in effect that is not currently listed in the Parent/Student Handbook. I have observed students wearing wrist bands that allow them to read & send text messages while in school. These are considered a means of texting and communicating and they are **prohibited**. Going forward, beginning on May 1, 2018, students who are seen with these high tech wrist bands/Apple watches will receive an automatic detention and the wrist bands will be confiscated and a parent will be called. Activity tracker Fit Bits that keep track of steps/heart rate will continue to be permitted. As always, if there is a reason to communicate with your child, the front office is available to send a message to him/her.

The entire staff is busy wrapping up the school year. When you look at the May/June calendar, you will see that there are many field trips and special activities planned for the students. As we enjoy these final weeks of the year, I want to ask parents to continue to encourage your child to stay on-task with their studies. Progress Book remains a great resource for parents to monitor assignments and grades.

<u>The following is important information regarding the uniforms for the 2018-2019 school</u> <u>year</u>. Remember, all of the old style gym uniforms and white polo shirts are no longer permitted. Both boys and girls need to wear a gray knit polo-style shirt that will include the SMS logo. (These shirts can ONLY be purchased at Luna Marketing or Schoolbelles). Girls still have the option to wear the navy blue polo shirt if they wish. The gym uniform consists of a gray t-shirt with the SMS logo and navy blue nylon shorts that also include the SMS logo. <u>The old gym uniform is no longer</u> <u>permitted!</u> The sweatpants and sweatshirts will stay the same.

Once again I would like to ask parents to <u>SLOW DOWN</u> in the school parking lot. Arrival and dismissal times are very busy and congested. For safety's sake, please enter the parking lot slowly, use the designated drop off lane, or use a marked parking space. The safety of your children is our first concern.

We are currently making decisions for class sizes, teachers and rooms for next year. If you have not returned your registration forms yet, please make it a priority to do so. The decisions we make will be based on registrations received. Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated.

Summer is a great time to relax and have fun. Some of our teachers do offer tutoring for students wanting a little extra help in not forgetting important lessons learned this school year. End of Year~ Important Dates

- There will be a Free Day for all students on Monday, May 28th, for Memorial Day.
- The last day for the 3-year-old Preschool students will be Tuesday, May 22nd.
- o The last day for the Preschool P4 and PK students will be Friday, May 25th.
- 0 Kindergarten students will end the school year on Friday, June 1st.
- o The last day for Grade 8 students will be Monday, June 4th.
- The last day for Grades 1-7 students will be Wednesday, June 6th.

Our Extended Care/Day Care will be open to accommodate Preschool and Kindergarten students after their last day of school, as well as, grades 1 through 8. <u>Registration for 2018-2019</u> school year must be completed and returned to the school for your child to be eligible to attend Summer Extended Care, Day Care, or Summer Camp.

4th Quarter Interims and Report Cards

These last few weeks of school are very important academically, and your child must continue learning and completing assignments on schedule. Please be aware that Interim Progress Reports will be sent home on May 11th, and final report cards on your child's last day of school.

First Communion

Congratulations to all of our Second Grade students, who will receive their First Communion on Sunday, May 6th at St. Mary Church from 11:30am-12:30pm. Mrs. Giblin has spent much of this school year preparing the children for this Holy Sacrament. The Second Grade students will spend May 4th, on a First Communion Retreat at the Fr. Garrity Center. This full day retreat concluded their preparation for the Sacrament as they made unleavened bread, created crafts, and visited the church. This is a special time for our little ones. They truly love their faith and their God.

Tuition and Fees

All tuition and fees for the current school year must be paid no later than May 15th, unless arrangements have been made with Father Singler. <u>All families, new and returning, MUST</u> <u>REGISTER ON LINE WITH FACTS MANAGEMENT BY MAY 15th FOR THE</u> <u>2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR.</u>

Acceptance letters have been sent to those families who have completed the registration process **and** are current with fees and tuition payments. The stipulation for returning next term remains, "contingent upon payment of all current tuition and fees"; this includes Extended Care and Preschool Day Care fees. If you have not received an acceptance letter, please contact the school office. Remember, if your child is not returning to SMS for the fall term you <u>must</u> inform the school office in writing.
