Students accepted into Preschool will receive a Physical Form to be completed by the pediatrician and returned to the school nurse prior to the first day of school.

Students registered for Kindergarten will be screened at SMS in March 2018. Parents of students accepted into the Kindergarten MUST complete a health form and return it to the school nurse PRIOR to the first day of school.

Parents of students entering in Grades 1-8 must complete a Transfer of Records Form that will allow SMS to request health and academic records from the school your child attended last year.

Note: It is expected that parishioners make a weekly contribution to the church using your family envelopes.

\$4,350 per child, Grade K-8 \$8,250 for two children \$11,350 for three or more children
