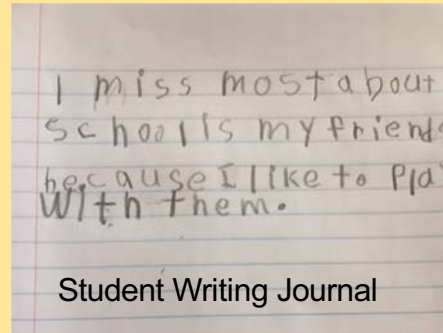

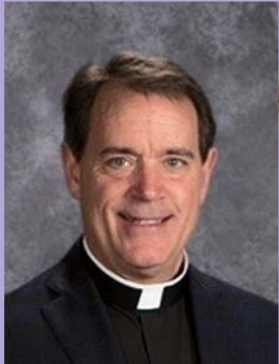
A message from the Kindergarten teacher.

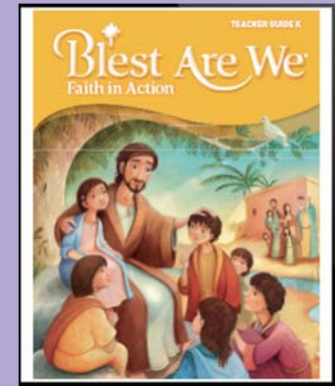
- Catholic Faith is an essential part of our program

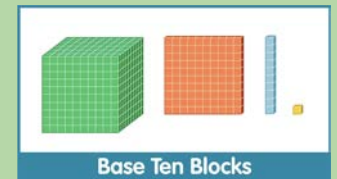
Social Skills
