Transitioning your child to school:

- Attend the Welcome activity before the school year begins
- Phase in schedule: child attends a shortened 1st day
- Short and sweet goodbyes are best
- Positive words "you <u>get</u> to go to school today"
- Set up daily school routines; routines are comforting

School Safety Procedures:

- Fire drills
- Tornado drills
- Lockdown drills
- The entire building is locked at all times
- Enter at the office (must be buzzed in)

Pick up and drop off procedures:

AM Classes

- 9am drop off at rear door of parking lot closest to playground.
- **P3: 11am** pick-up at same door.
- P4: 11:30am pick-up at same door.

PM Classes

- 12:45pm drop off at front of building in circle drive by statue of St. Mary.
- 3:05pm pick-up at rear
 door of parking lot closest
 to playground.

Preschool Day Care available:

- Hours 6:30am-6pm Monday-Friday
- Only students enrolled in SMS preschool
- Annual registration fee \$25
- Hourly rate: \$4 per hour
- A cap of \$28 per day
- Must provide packed lunch and snacks in separate bags.
- Milk can be purchased for lunch (\$5 for 20 tickets)

If your child is ill:

- Notify the office in the morning
- Follow school guidelines for returning to school
- Follow school policy for sending in medication for your child
- o If your child becomes ill at school you will be notified

Discipline Policy:

- Redirection
- No timeouts
- Discussion with teacher
- Conference/phone call to parent If needed
