



### **Governance & Council Operations**

The School Advisory Council formally adopted its Governance Charter, which outlines the Council's advisory role, structure, and commitment to supporting school leadership, with final decisions remaining with the Principal and Pastor.

### **Planning for Growth**

The Advisory Council is evaluating class structure and instructional approaches in upper grades to support large class sizes in some grades while maintaining strong academics and a close-knit learning environment. There is a focus on creating a model that serves the current classes and remains sustainable as large classes move upward and enrollment varies.

### **Reviewed the Expanded Preschool Options**

Beginning in 2026–2027, families of four-year-olds will be able to choose between half-day and full-day preschool, while the three-year-old program will remain unchanged. The program will utilize current staff and resources, with additional communication and family support planned.

### **Goal for Balanced School Investment**

Enhancements to early childhood programs are designed to strengthen long-term enrollment and do not reduce focus or resources for grades 4 - 8.

### **Focus on Long-Term Sustainability**

Ongoing planning aims to support academic excellence, stable enrollment, and strong program offerings across all grade levels with a strong commitment to staff satisfaction and engagement.

### **Communication & Continuous Improvement**
