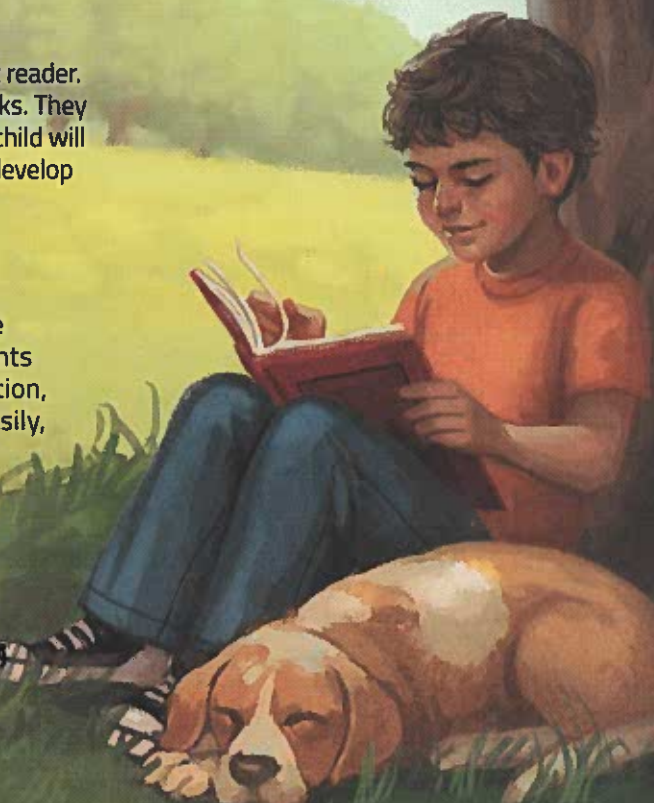

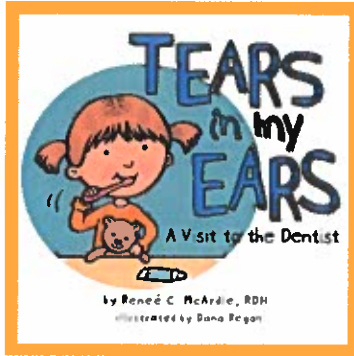


This letter is to inform you that, due to financial constraints beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, Strongsville City Schools will only be providing one bus for transportation to your school.
