REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Registration deadline has been extended to October 26. The cost for basketball is \$130/athlete; cheerleading is \$100/athlete, payment due at the time of registration. Late registrations may be taken until November 15 (pending space on teams). Fee will increase \$20 for late registrations. We accept credit card payments only. To assist, we accept partial payments but expect that payment is made in full before the winter season begins. Registration fees cover CYO registration fees, 8-10 season games plus additional tournaments (up to 2 per team), uniforms, equipment, facility upkeep . . . and a NEW GYM FLOOR!
