Matthew 1:18

18 This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about : His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. 19 Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly. 20 But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." 22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: 23 "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" (which means "God with us"). 24When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. 25 But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus.

Eighth Grade Students and Parents

High School Selection Week will be held in January. The eighth grade students have been given a variety of opportunities to assist them in making an informed choice for high school. Mr. Jones has worked with each child to secure high school visitation days. Students received the ACAD (Association of Catholic Admission Directors) High School magazine listing all Open Houses and admission testing dates.

Your child is encouraged to spend some time over the holiday break making a final decision on where to apply and writing an application essay. Remember the application essay may be the first and only chance your child has to impress the administrators of the high school they are hoping to attend.

Parents of eighth grade students should be aware that 2^{nd} Quarter grades will be sent with the application. The selected high school will then expect parents to send a copy of your child's final June report card.

Scholarship Fund
