A Day in 2nd Grade

<u>Religion</u> - In 2nd grade your child will develop a deeper relationship with God as we prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion. The students will also learn about prayer, the mass, and our Catholic beliefs.

Reading - Second graders will focus on reading comprehension skills. They will continue to work on oral reading fluency and expression skills.

<u>Phonics and Spelling</u> - This year the students learn different spelling patterns for the long vowels, suffixes, prefixes, and contractions.

<u>English and Writing</u> - Students continue to work on sentence structure and editing sentences, common, proper, and possessive nouns, verbs, and adjectives. They will progress to writing longer stories using topic and closing sentences and adding more details to writing.

<u>Math</u> - Second graders continue to practice addition and subtraction facts through 18. Another big focus is adding and subtracting with 2 digit numbers.

Handwriting - In November 2nd grade students begin to learn cursive handwriting.

<u>Social Studies - Science - Health</u> - These subjects are taught throughout the school year.
