

Summer reading 4th & 5th grades

Choose one of the following suggested books:

“The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane,” a beautiful story about an arrogant porcelain rabbit who learns about love and loss on an unexpected journey. (Kate DiCamillo)

“Fish in a Tree” is an inspiring story about a girl with dyslexia who learns to overcome her fears. (Lynda Mullaly Hunt)

“Funny Girl” by Betsy Bird, read about tales of babysitting!

“The Last Mapmaker” is a story about going on a dangerous expedition. (Christina Soontornvat)

“Playing the Cards You’re Dealt With” by Varian Johnson. This compelling story blends card game strategy with tough life lessons.

When finished reading:

1. Create a small poster that includes the following:
2. Title, clearly write the title of your book on the poster.
3. Author, clearly write the full name of the author on your poster.
4. Main characters, list the main characters from the book on your poster.
5. Summary, write a summary of the book you read and add to your poster. (1/2 to 1 page in length)

6. Pictures, draw or print and attach pictures about the setting, main characters, and one major event from the book.

This project will be worth 35 points for reading next year! Have a great summer.
